



# Support for Carers Program Newsletter | July 2023




Dear all,

I am absolutely delighted to announce that The Southern Migrant Refugee Centre (SMRC) celebrated its 30th anniversary at State Parliament on Friday 16 June.

The event was attended by over 100 people, including members of Parliament, Lee Tarlamis MP, Pauline Richards MP, Belinda Wilson MP, Nina Taylor MP, Cassandra Fernando Federal MP and Lana Formoso Deputy Mayor City of Greater Dandenong and CEOs and members from our stakeholder organisations and supporters. Since 1993, SMRC has supported the settlement of newly arrived refugees and provided services for migrants and refugees across Melbourne's southeast region. SMRC could not have delivered fantastic services and achieved the outcome without significant commitment by our loyal and passionate staff, volunteers, our partners, and funding from the Federal, State and Local Government bodies.

#### WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN CARER ALLOWANCE AND CARER PAYMENT?

The Australian Government provides a range of payments, benefits and concessions for eligible carers. The two main payments are Carer Allowance and Carer Payment.

- Carer Allowance is an income supplement available to people who provide daily care and attention in a private home to a person with disability or a severe medical condition.
- Carer Payment is an income support payment for people who are unable to support themselves through substantial paid employment because of the demands of their caring role.

Carer Payment is income and assets tested and paid at the same rate as other social security pensions.


#### **HOW TO BOOK FOR OUR ACTIVITIES:**
